

 $\label{eq:Table C} Table \ C$ Key Signatures & Circle of 5th's



Time Signatures



Labeled Keyboard (w/ Enharmonic Equivalents)






Table G Articulations

slurred Legato: Connected air and sound. 'd' tongue Slurred for valves/keys,'d' tongue for slides. **Tenuto:** Hold note for full value. Connected air and clear tongue. Staccato: Short and separated by air. Think "tah" NOT "TAT". **Accented:** Strong front of the note; release the air with the tongue. Emphasize the note.


Marcato:

Strong front of note, with

separated air.

"Short and fat".

- The note given is that which gets the beat; quarter, half, and eighth notes are most common.
- ** Each tick of the Second Hand on a clock = 60 BPM. Double that tick = 120 BPM. **



Rhythm Tree and Counting Syllables


